

HOW TO CALL FOR HELP

CALL 9-1-1 OR YOUR LOCAL EMERGENCY NUMBER

Tell the operator:

1. The reason you are calling.
2. Where you are calling from.
3. Your name.
4. Your address.

Don't hang up until the operator tells you to.

Be sure you always have important numbers near your telephone at home for quick use in an emergency. Often, the most important thing is to get help and get it fast!
